#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Designates a bridge on State Route 2026 in Buffington Township, Indiana County, as the First Lieutenant Theodore P. Pytash Memorial Bridge.

#### **SUMMARY:**

A bridge on State Route 2026 is being designated as the First Lieutenant Theodore P. Pytash Memorial Bridge for the following reasons:

- First Lieutenant Pytash was drafted into the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict and served with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Platoon, Company A, 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion, 9<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division.
- First Lieutenant Pytash was awarded the Silver Star Medal for his courageous leadership when
  his platoon came under attack in the Republic of Vietnam on May 31, 1970. He also received the
  National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal,
  Combat Infantryman Badge, Purple Heart, Army Commendation Medal and Bronze Star Medal.

PennDOT shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

Effective Date: 60 days.
