






PTC VS PA GENERAL OBLIGATION DEBT





OPERATING BUDGET GROWTH







E-ZPass Penetration Growth: Commercial vs. Passenger











Original PA Turnpike section (four lanes) in Cumberland County near milepost 210.












TOLL-ROAD COMPARISON




TOLL INCREASES (COMPOUNDED)


