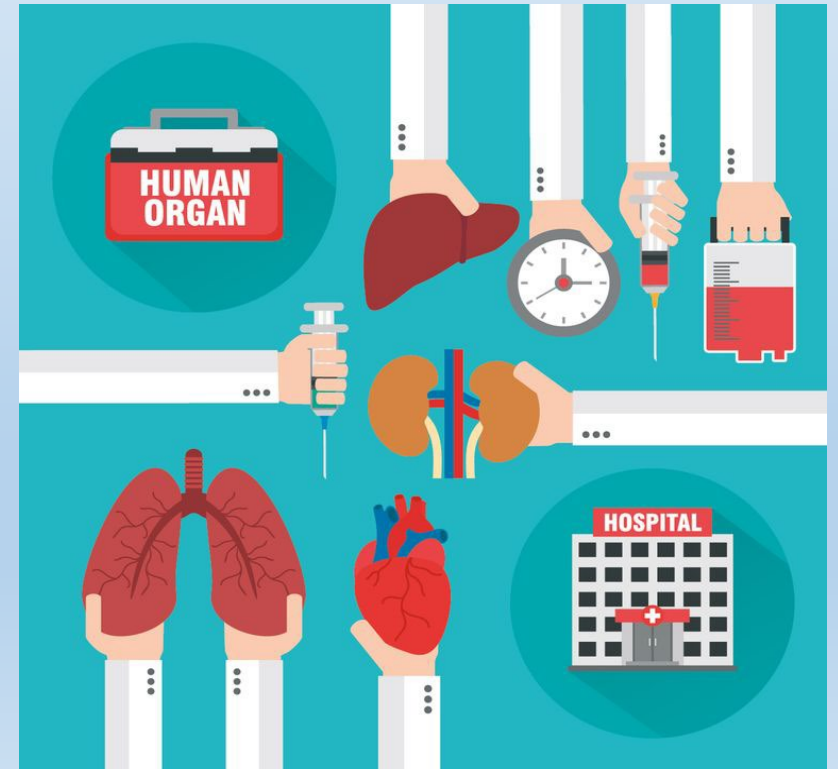

Pennsylvania Aviation Advisory Committee

- Formed in 1999 to advise the Governor, General Assembly, Secretary of Transportation, and State Transportation Commission on aviation matters.
- 25 member committee made up of the Secretaries of Transportation, Community and Economic Development, Chairman and Minority Chairman of the Transportation Committee of the Senate and of the House of Representatives
- 19 other members with experience and knowledge of air transportation activities throughout this Commonwealth
- All members appointed by the Governor
- Task-specific subcommittees
 - Aviation Funding
 - Aviation Workforce, Economic Impact and Partnerships
 - Air Freight and Commercial Air Service
 - Aviation Technology
 - Legislative and Policy
